Mrs. Margaret Fleming

Services for Mrs. Margaret (Hite) Fleming, 93, were held Saturday, July 24 in the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel with the Rev. K. Oliver Brekke officiating. Burial was in the Verdon cemetery.

Mrs. Fleming died Wednesday in St. Paul, Minn.

Music was provided by Margaret and Myrtle Blader who sang, "His Eye Is On the Sparrow," and "Rock of Ages," accompanied by Mrs. Robert Wegner.

She was married to Alex Fleming in Eldorado, Ill., in 1935. Mr. Fleming died in 1945.

Survivors include two sons, Bert Hite, Randolph; and Archie Hite, St. Paul; one daughter, Mrs. William Whittier, Baldwin Park, Calif.; three grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. She was also preceded in death by one daughter.
