

Mrs. Elizabeth Froehle . ✓ Dies After Short Illness

Mrs. Elizabeth Froehle, 54, a highly respected lady of this city, passed away at her home here last Friday morning. The cause of her death was apoplexy of the brain, from which she suffered an attack last Tuesday and never recovered.

Mrs. Froehle was born in Imlay City, Mich., July 23, 1876, and was married November 22, 1911, to Clement Froehle, of Groton. She has three sisters, Mrs. Mary A. Lockwood, Mrs. Waller A. Fischer and Mrs. Louise C. Day, all of Detroit, Mich., who survive and also two brothers and one son. The brothers are Joe Donovan, of this vicinity, and Charles of Missoula, Mont.

The funeral was held at the Catholic church on Monday of this week, and the remains laid to rest in the church's burying ground north of Groton. The funeral was conducted by Rev. Shanley, of Andover.
