Mrs. Herman Schornack Gengerke was born in Danzig, Germany, June 13, 1852, came to the United States in 1873 and was united in marriage to Mr. Herman Gengerke shortly afterwards. They made their home in Oshkosh, Wis., until 1888, when they moved unto their farm, five miles northwest of Groton, on which they lived until 1920, when they moved to Groton. Mr. Gengerke preceded his wife to the Great Beyond on April 17, 1921.

Mrs. Gengerke passed away at 3:00 a. m., Thursday, Nov. 8.

To this union were born eleven children, three dying in infancy. Those left to mourn are John of Amanda Dobberpuhl, Gust and Frank of Groton, and Herman of Verona, N.
