Services for Miss Isabel D. Gerth, 77, 121 South Kline Street, Aberdeen, were held Friday, April 11, at 2 p.m., at Gates, Vik Funeral Home in Aberdeen with the Rev. LeRoy Flagstad of Bethlehem Lutheran Church of Aberdeen officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.
