Services for Mrs. Julie Sieh Giesen, 82, were held at 9:00 a. m., Saturday in Minneapolis. Burial was in a cemetery in that city. She died last Wednesday in her Minneapolis home after an illness of two years.

Mrs. Giesen, a member of a pioneer Brown County family, was born in Wisconsin on April 6, 1873, coming to the James area in 1885. She was married to John E. Giesen at Aberdeen in 1897, and lived in this area until 1904.
