## Agnes L. Graves

Mrs. Agnes L. Graves, 77, pioneer of the Scotland vicinity, southeast of Groton, died Monday afternoon at St. Luke's hospital in Aberdeen, after an illness of two weeks' duration.

She resided in Aberdeen, but was a long-time resident of the Scotland community, to which place she came with her parents in 1883.

Agnes Lillias Denholm was born March 22, 1874, at Odell, Ill. She was married in 1895 to Ed. D. Graves and they farmed for many years, southeast of Groton. She was an active member of the Rebekah lodge at Verdon.

Surviving are six sons, Harold, Charles, Morris and Frank of Bath, and William and Edmond of Aberdeen; a sister, Mrs. J. A. Nutt of Inglewood, Calif., and two brothers, A. R. Denholm, Kirkland, Wash., and Charles E. Denholm, Rockport, Mo. Her husband and a daughter, Agnes, died previously.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, at 2:00 p. m., at the Paetz-nick Funeral Home, with the Rev. L. C. Benson officiating. Burial will be in the Scotland cemetery.
