Former Groton Man Dies in Minneapolis

The remains of Ben G.^{H.} Green, a former resident of this city, arrived in Groton last Friday morning for burial in Groton cemetery.

Mr. Greene died in a Minneapolis hospital following an attack of the heat, at the age of 71 years. He was residing at Stanchfield, Minn., at the time of his death.

Mr. Green was born at Oswego, N. Y., and lived there for a number of years before coming to South Dakota. He was married in 1907 to Miss Lulu Rogers, a daughter of Charles Rogers of this city, and they made their home on a farm near town until they removed to Stanchfield, where they have since made their home.

He is survived by his wife, one brother and four sisters, and was the youngest of a family of eight.

The funeral was held Sunday and the remains laid to rest in Groton cemetery. The services were conducted by Rev. J. L. Norris, of the local Methodist church.
