

# Gladys R. Green

Funeral services for Gladys R. Green, 88, were held Tuesday, March 24, 1987 at Augustana Lutheran Church, rural Claremont with the Rev. Kathy King officiating. Burial was in Augustana Cemetery. She died March 20 at Colonial Manor, Groton.

Gladys was born January 4, 1899 in Riverside Township to Fred and Nell (Dickerson) Green. She grew up on a farm nine miles northwest of Claremont, clerked in Brooberg-Archer Dry Goods Store in Groton until her marriage to Carl E. Green on November 23, 1921 at Langford. They farmed six miles south of Claremont. She moved into Groton about 12 years ago and entered the Colonial Manor Nursing Home three years ago.
