William J. Grouell

Funeral services for William J. Grouell, 83, Pioneer, Calif., were held Tuesday, Aug. 29 at 10 a. m., in the Pine Grove Community Church with Rev. Henry Church in charge. Committal services were held at Inglewood Park Cemetery, Thursday.

Mr. Grouell, a native of Iowa, collapsed at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Jud Roberts of Pioneer and was dead on arrival at the Amador Hospital Saturday, Aug. 26. He had resided in the county for three years following his retirement from a Los Angeles paint firm.

He was a former farmer in the Putney area and resided on the farm now occupied by the Harry Pharis Sr. family. He was a member of the Presbyterian church in Groton and active in the Putney Community Club. The family moved to a farm at Ida Grove, Ia. in 1927.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood.

The deceased is survived by his daughters, Mrs. Roberts of Pioneer and Lucille Potter of Anoka, Minn., brother, Arthur Grouell, Iowa; sister, Nannie Young of Spokane, Wash.; nine grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. He was the father of the late Giles N. Grouell who died in 1965.
