S. A. Guthrie, Well Known Here, Summoned To Rest

S. A. Guthrie, well known resident of Farmington township and former Day county legislator, passed away at 4:00 o'clock Monday morning at the Peabody Memorial Hospital following a short illness.

He is survived by two sons, Fred of Minneapolis and Frank at home. Another son, Harry and a daughter, Vera (Mrs. Roy Adams) passed away about a year ago and his wife about four years ago.

The funeral, in charge of the Masonic lodge of Pierpont, was held Wednesday afternoon with burial at Homer cemetery.

Mr. Guthrie had been ill for about 10 days, thought to have been brought about as a result of over-exertion while crying an auction sale. He contracted pneumonia and was brought to the Peabody hospital for treatment but returned home. He suffered a relapse and was brought back to the hospital last Friday night by ambulance.—Pierpont Signal.
