MRS. FLORA HALE

Mrs. Flora B. Hale died at the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Otto Krahn of Bath Corners, Friday evening. She was 86 years old.

Flora Belle Crary was born Sept. 22, 1861, at Richland Center, Wis., where she grew to womanhood. She was married in 1881 to John W. Hale at Union Center, Wis. They resided at Elroy and Hillsborough, Wis. After the death of her husband, Mrs. Hale came to South Dakota with her children, settling in Woonsocket. Two years later they moved to Aberdeen. In 1913 she went to make her home with her son-in-law and daughter in the Groton vicinity. In 1942 they moved to the present home.

Surviving, in addition to her daughter, Mrs. Krahn, is a brother, A. B. Crary, Dane, Wis. Two sons, a daughter and her husband preceded her in death. Grandchildren surviving include Mrs. Herbert Radke and Mrs. Hilbert Radke, Stratford, and Billie Krahn of Bath. Five great grandchildren also survive.

Services were held at the Huebl chapel in Aberdeen at 2:30 p. m. on Tuesday. The Christian Science service was conducted. Mrs. George Robertson was the reader and burial was in Riverside cemetery.
