Mrs. Clarence (Eva) Hansen, 84, died March 21, 1991. Burial was in the Dell Rapids Cemetery at Dell Rapids, South Dakota. Yahn and Sons Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.

Eva Morse was born on August 20, 1906 at Ramona, South Dakota. She moved with her family to Huffton in 1910 where she attended school until graduating from the eighth grade. She attended Groton High School for four years, graduating in 1925. She attended Northern State College, Aberdeen, and received her teacher's certificate. She taught in country schools in Riverside and Claremont Townships for seven years. She became postmaster in Huffton in 1931 serving until 1963 when she moved to Groton. She moved to Seattle, Wash., in 1974.

She married Clarence Hansen on August 20, 1944 in Huffton. He died on September 14, 1960.

Survivors include one sister, Jennie Falk, Minneapolis, Minn.; one brother, James Webster Morse, Kent, Wash.; six nieces and numerous great nieces and nephews and cousins.
