Vernita Harry, 92, of Ferney died February 12th at Beverly Healthcare Center in Groton. Services are 11 a.m. on February 17th at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Ferney. Rev. Lloyd Redhage will officiate. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen under the direction Paetzick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

Visitation will be held at the chapel from 4-8 p.m. on Sunday with a prayer service at 7 p.m. There will an hour of visitation at the church on Monday prior to the service.
