## Charles Hein

Funeral services for Charles Hein, 87, Andover were held Wednesday, Sept. 2, at Zion Lutheran Church in Andover with the Rev. Larry I. Geyer officiating.

Mr. Hein died Sunday, Aug. 30, at the Day County Hospital in Webster.

Burial was in the Andover Cemetery. The Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.
