## Mrs. C. R. Henderson

Funeral services for Mrs. C. R. Henderson were held at the Hettinger Lutheran Church, June 29, at 2 p. m., with Pastor E. W. Brandt officiating.

Mrs. Henderson passed away on June 27 at St. Luke's Nursing Home at Dickinson after a short illness. Her age was 75 years.

Minnie May Herron was born Mar. 6, 1886, to Anna and Joseph Myers Herron, who lived in Brown County near Groton. It was in this community that she grew up, attending school in Brown County. She and Chester R. Henderson of the same community were united in marriage Sept. 20, 1905. The following year, in 1906, they came by covered wagon to Perkins County and settled on a homestead ne. Lodgepole, S. D.

Three sons were born to this union. Mrs. Henderson lived the busy, useful life of a pioneer homemaker. In 1951 for reasons of health, the Hendersons left their farm and moved to Hettinger, where they lived until July 6, 1959 at which time they entered the home where Mr. Henderson passed away on Oct. 5 1959. Also preceding her in death were her parents and two brothers, Ray and Guy of Groton.

Surviving her are her three sons, Kenneth and Vinton of Lodgepole and Basil of Philip; ten grandchildren, eleven great grandchildren, two sisters, Mrs. Raymond Wing, Groton and Miss Grace Herron, Aberdeen; one brother, Walter Herron, Groton.
