

Ulic M. Henehan Jr. 3-22-89

BRITTON - The funeral for Ulic M. Henehan Jr., 68, Britton, was held Friday, March 17 in First Lutheran Church in Britton. The Rev. Emil Greiner officiated.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. He died Tuesday, March 14, 1989, at a Fargo hospital.

Ulic M. Henehan Jr. was born December 4, 1920, in Seattle, Wash. He graduated from Garfield High School in Seattle, then attended the University of Washington. He was in the Naval ROTC. He enlisted in the Air Corps in September 1942. He graduated from pilot training in 1944. He served as an instructor for B-26s in Shreveport, La., and in Del Rio, Texas. He was discharged in 1946 and returned to the University of Washington. He moved to Britton in June 1947.

He married DeLores (Hinrichs) Bohle at Claremont, July 7, 1951.

They made their home in Britton. He worked for Thorp Auto Co. for 10 years. He began farming in the Claremont area in 1957. He later expanded to include the Thorp ranches.

He served in the Air Force and the Air Force Reserves for 30 years, retiring as a lieutenant colonel. He was a member of the American Legion and Reserved Officers Association.

Survivors include his wife of Britton; three daughters, Mrs. James (Barbara) Kuske, Houghton, Mrs. Robert (Patricia) Parrow, Britton, and Theresa Henehan, Sioux Falls; three sons, Ulic M. Henehan III, Britton, Brian Henehan, Dallas, Texas, and Burke Henehan, McKinney, Texas; and one grandson.
