LeRoy "Bud" Herron, 68, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, Aberdeen, Wednesday, May 11, 1994.

His funeral was Saturday, May 14, 1994, at St. John's Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Dwaine Doremus officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in charge of arrangements.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, one granddaughter, one brother and three sisters.
