## Walter Herron

The funeral services for Walter Herron, 93, Groton were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Emmanuel Lutheran Church of Groton with the Rev. F. Philip Strain officiating.

Burial was in Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetz-nick-Garness Funeral Chapel of Groton.

He died Saturday, Feb. 1, 1986, at Colonial Manor at Groton.

Casketbearers were Ron Adler, Otis Belden, Donald Clocksene, Steve Herron, Juel Kolbo and Rang-vald Larsen. All of his friends were considered honorary casket-bearers.

Walter Herron was born February 19, 1892, in West Hanson Township, to Joseph and Anna Larson Herron. He attended school in the area and Aberdeen Business College. He married Mattie Phillips December 23, 1923, at Webster.

They farmed near Groton until 1944 when they moved into Groton. He worked as a mechanic for Herron Case Implement Dealership of Gro-ton and retired in 1955. His wife, died in 1984 and he entered the nursing home in November 1985.

He was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Gwynne (Dawn) Jones, Bath; four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one son, two brothers and three sisters.
