Services for Rix R. Hinckley, 40, Seattle, Wash., and former Groton resident, were held Thursday, April 8, at 2 p.m., at Paetznick - Garness Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Marvin McPhee officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery with military rites conducted by Groton Post No. 39 of the American Legion.

Mr. Hinckley died Friday, April 2, at his home in Seattle.

A scriptural wake service was held at 8:30 p.m. Wednesday at the chapel.

Lee Schinkel sang "The Lord's Prayer" and "How Great Thou Art," accompanied by Mrs. Kenneth Alberts, organist.

Mr. Hinckley was born June 3, 1935, at Groton. He graduated from Aberdeen Central High School and attended Northern State College. He served in the Korean conflict in the Marine Corps. He was a member of the Aberdeen American Legion Post and the Eagles Lodge of Seattle. He owned and operated A&R Industries in Seattle.
