Lyle J. Hitchcock, 72, Groton died at Colonial Manor, Groton, Sunday, Dec. 12, 1993.

The funeral was held at Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, Friday, Dec. 17, 1993, with the Rev. William Duncan officiating. Burial in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen.
