Arnold Hobus

Funeral services for Arnold Hobus, 56, of 624 S. Roosevelt, Aberdeen, were held at 10 a.m., Tuesday, May 11, at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in Groton with the Rev. F. Philip Strain officiating.

Burial was in the Andover Cemetery.

Mr. Hobus was dead on arrival from a heart attack Friday, May 7, at St. Luke's Hospital.

Casketbearers were Glen Baule, Andover; Carlyle Mardian, Don Bachman, Bill Jensen, Dale Jensen and Theodore Brockel, all of Aberdeen. Mrs. Ben Anderson was the organist. Clarence Baule, Andover, soloist sang "Abide With Me" and "How Great Thou Art".

Arnold J. Hobus was born August 29, 1925, at Aberdeen. He attended Aberdeen Central High School and served in the U.S. Navy for four years during World War II. He married Margaret Krieger August 26, 1951, at Aberdeen. He lived in the Aberdeen area all of his life where he was self-employed as a carpenter and blacksmith. He was also active in muzzle loading events.

Survivors include his widow; one daughter, Mrs. Dave (June) Clark, Boone, Iowa; one brother, Leroy, North Dakota; two sisters, Mrs. Kenneth (Delores) Anderson and Mrs. Lawrence (Jeanette) Wiseman, both of Aberdeen; and one granddaughter.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one son.
