

Orville R. Holler

The funeral for Orville Holler, 69, Pierpont, was held at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Pierpont at 10 a.m. Saturday, July 25. The Rev. Donald Torala officiated.

Mr. Holler died at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls Wednesday, July 22, 1987, following an extended illness.

Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens in Aberdeen. Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, was in charge of arrangements.
