Rites For Anna Holum Held in Aberdeen Tuesday

At the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Aberdeen at 2:30 Tuesday afternoon of last week, funeral services were held for Anna Holum, with the Rev. A. Elmer Moe officiating. Mrs. C. C. Lee and Mrs. Waldemar Larson sang three selections, accompanied at the organ by Merritt Johnson. Members of the Ladies' Aid and Circle No. 3 of the Bethlehem Lutheran church attended in a body.
