ONALASKA, Wis. - The funeral for Ursula Hoops, 63, of Onalaska, Wis., and formerly of Ferney, was held Tuesday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Ferney. The Rev. Barrie Henke, Onalaska, officiated.
