After an illness of two weeks duration, Mrs. Dora Hoppe quietly passed away Sunday afternoon at 4:15.

Mrs. Hoppe was born in Germany April 12, 1848. With her husband and family came to this country twenty-four years ago, locating at Groton, which had been her home ever since. Shortly after coming here she became ill and had been an almost helpless invalid for the past twenty-three years. Her last illness was rheumatism of the heart and death came very sudden and unexpectedly.
