### HENRY HOPPE

The remains of Henry Hoppe, former resident, of Groton, were interred in the Groton cemetery on July 5th, following services at the Wilson Funeral Home in Aberdeen with the Rev. Arthur Atack of the M. E. church officiating.

Mr. Hoppe was a kindly neighbor, whose life was beset with many hardships not least of which was his invalid wife. Mrs. Hoppe spent many of the last years of her life in a wheel chair, older residents in Groton recall. Three sons, Max, Julius and Paul, have long since moved to other parts of the country and the only known relative of the deceased in the community is a step-daughter, Mrs. Fred Wilbur, of Bath.
