

# Alvin Hornaman

Funeral services for Alvir O. Hornaman were held in St. Paul's Church in Henderson, Minn., May 2, at 11:00 a.m. The Rev. Walter Fischer officiated. Interment was in Mount Cemetery.

He died April 30 in the cardiac unit of the Mankato Hospital.

Mr. Hornaman was born May 7, 1919, to Albert and Irene Pagel Hornaman near Ferney.
