## Al C. Hoy

Funeral services for Al C. Hoy, 70, Jefferson, Iowa, retired businessman and former Groton resident, were held September 21 from the Slinger Chapel in Jefferson with the Rev. R. Roland Ritter, minister of the United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in the Jefferson Cemetery.

He died September 19 at the Greene County Medical Center in Jefferson.

Al C. Hoy was born July 6, 1906, at Northfield, the son of Samuel and Blanche Cadwell Hoy. He was reared at Groton, and graduated from Groton High School with the class of 1924.

He attended Huron College and was a grocer in Redfield, Des Moines, Iowa, and then operated his own store in Jefferson, beginning in 1950.

He was married to Hazelle Valentine at Groton on August 18, 1929.

He was active in many community affairs and was an avid sportsman in Jefferson. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, the B.P.O.E. Lodge No. 2306 and a past president of the Iowa Golf Association.

Survivors include his widow; one daughter (Mrs. W.P. (Jacquie) Owen of Jefferson; one granddaughter; and three brothers, John Hoy of Titusville, Fla., Roger Hoy of Salem, Ore., and Ed Hoy of San Mateo, Calif.
