## Glenn Hubbard

Glenn S. Hubbard, 70, 1335 N. Evans Street, McMinnville, Ore., an executive of Dairy Queen and retired educator, died Thursday, Dec. 7, at his home.

Services were held Monday, Dec. 11, at 2 p.m. at Macy and Son Mortuary. Interment was at Evergreen Memorial Park Mausoleum.

Mr. Hubbard was born September 21, 1902, to Andrew and Alice Hubbard in Mt. Tabor, Wis. He moved to South Dakota with his family and attended the Groton School, graduating from high school with the class of 1919. He was married to Beulah Beavers of Doland. He taught school in Doland and Grand Forks, N.D., and was also an assistant coach at Dakota Wesleyan University at Mitchell. His team won three state basketball championships in South Dakota.

After moving to McMinnville in 1947, he coached basketball two years at Linfield College and then taught for twenty years until his retirement at McMinnville Junior High School where he was also vice principal at the school.

Hubbard was executive vice-president of Dairy Queen of the Pacific Northwest since 1958, and for the past year West Coast marketing representative of International Dairy Queen.
