OBITUARY.

Mrs. Mary Hurlbut, wife of R. R. Hurlbut, died at her home three miles northeast of Groton Sunday night. Deceased had a partial stroke of paralysis last fall, and had been ill from then to the time of her death. Her maiden name was Mary Stebbins, and she was born at St. Albans, Vt., in 1829, and hence was sixty years of age. R. R. Hurlbut and family were among the early pioneers of Minnesota, having settled at Dayton, Hennepin County, in 1855. They removed to Groton in 1882. The funeral services occurred at the Methodist church Tuesday afternoon and the remains were laid to rest in Union Cemetery, whither they were followed by a large number of the friends and relatives of the deceased.
