Fred Iberg Expires After Long Illness

Fred Iberg, one of the early pioneers of this city, died Sunday night at 12 o'clock, following an illness from which he has suffered for the past several years. He was 72 years of age at the time of his death.

Mr. Iberg was born at Alma, Wis., on October 9, 1859 and was married to Miss Amelia Kraft on October 16, 1886. He came to Groton in 1889 and since then has made his home here.

He is survived by his wife and one son, Edwin. Also two sisters, Mrs. Augusta Johnson, of Alma, Wis., and Mrs. William Maier, of Maiden Rock, Wis.; two brothers, Otto Iberg, of Noonan, N. D., and Arthur Iberg, of Alma, Wis. Four great grandchildren and two grandchildren are also left to mourn his loss.

The deceased was a member of the Evangelical church for many years. The funeral was held at the home Wednesday afternoon at 1:00 o'clock, conducted by Rev. Luther Benson, of the Methodist church and the remains laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
