

# *Keith Joseph Marion Inglis*

Keith Joseph Marion Inglis, 88, Groton, died Thursday, Feb. 22, at Beverly Healthcare Center, Groton. His funeral was held Monday, Feb. 26, 2001, at the United Methodist Church, Groton, with the Rev. Richard Collman officiating. Burial followed in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Keith Joseph Marion Inglis was born October 18, 1912, in Verdon, to William and Inga (Swenson) Inglis. Keith attended the Groton Public School and in 1929 he graduated. At the age of 17, he started working for the Ferney Farmers Elevator in Groton and later managed the Ferney Farmers Elevator in James until the elevator was moved to Groton. He worked in the Groton elevator until his retirement in 1975.

Keith married Ethel Totzke in Groton on March 15, 1941. They lived in the Groton area all their lives. Ethel died in 1996.
