

Algot E. Johnson, 90

Algot E. (Augie) Johnson, 90, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, Aberdeen, Monday, Jan. 10, 1994. ¹⁻¹⁵⁻⁹⁴

The funeral was held at the United Methodist Church, Groton, Friday, Jan. 14, 1994, with the Rev. Dean Trapp officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton. A prayer service was held at the chapel, Thursday, Jan. 10, with Masonic Rites by the Groton Masonic Lodge.
