Services for Mrs. Alfred L. (Pearl) Johnson, 78, Huron resident, were held at 10 a.m., Saturday, April 26, at the Welter Funeral Home in Huron, and at 2:30 p.m. at the local United Methodist Church with the Rev. John Maines officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

She died Wednesday evening at St. John's Regional Medical Center in Huron.

They made their home on a farm two miles south of Groton until 1940 when they moved to Huron where Mr. Johnson was chairman of the South Dakota Production and Marketing Administration. Mrs. Johnson was a member of the Eastern Star and the Rebekah Lodge in Groton.
