The funeral for Jennie K. Jones, 90, Aberdeen, was held Monday, May 11 at First Presbyterian Church with Rev. Gerald Rife, Jr., officiating. Burial was at Sunset Memorial Gardens. Mrs. Jones died on Wednesday, May 6, at St. Luke's Hospital.

Jennie K. Jones was born at Spain, S.D. on April 21, 1897 to Tom and Alice Jones. When she was a child the family moved to Langford. This is where she attended school and graduated from Langford High School with the Class of 1917. She then attended Northern Normal and Industrial School and received her teaching certificate. She taught in Spain and Langford area. On October 5, 1921 she was married to David J. Jones at St. Paul, Minn. They made their home and farmed in the Spain area until 1956 when they moved to Phoenix, Ariz., where she became a L.P.N. In 1960 the family moved to Aberdeen. She worked as a L.P.N. at St. Luke's Hospital then at Mother Joseph Manor where she worked until her retire-

ment in 1971.

Mrs. Jones was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Aberdeen, the Pasque Club of Aberdeen, the Royal Neighbors, and the VFW Auxiliary of Britton. She was a past member of the Aberdeen Gray Ladies and the South Dakota LPN Association. She was also a member of the United Presbyterian Women.

Survivors include one daughter, Lorraine Rix, Aberdeen; two brothers, Newton Jones and Kenneth Jones, both of Langford; two grandchildren and five great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, two brothers, two sisters and one grandson.

The casketbearers were Ramon Jones, Kenneth Jones, Jr., and Bruce Likness, all of Langford, Curtis Jones, Britton, Dennis Larson, Groton and Roger Jones, Watertown. The honorary pallbearers were all of her friends. The ushers were Maurice Jones and Ralph I. Peterson. The organist was Mrs. John Evens and the soloist was Sheila Blomster.
