Services for Joseph P. Jost, 90, were held at 2 p. m., Thursday, Nov. 21, at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Harvey Feustel, Aberdeen officiating. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.

Mr. Jost passed away Monday at the Mother Joseph Manor in Aberdeen.
