MRS. F. M. JUDKINS

After an extended period of sickness, the death of Mrs. F. M. Judkins occurred at her home south of Groton on Friday last.

Funeral services were held at the M. E. Church at 2:00 on Sunday afternoon, the auditorium being packed by sympathizing friends and neighbors, who assembled to pay their last respects to the departed. The male quartet of the M. E. choir furnished the music, rendering several appropriate selections. Rev. Brown's sermon was brief, thoughtful and impressive. His reference to the departed, whom he had never known, was to the effect that she had accepted the Christian faith under the pastorate of Rev. Hyde, who organized the Methodist Church in Groton, and that he had been assured that he "could not say too much regarding her character as a devoted wife and mother."

Deceased was nearly forty-two years of age. Came here from Iowa in 1883, and was married to F. M. Judkins in 1887.

Besides her husband she is survived by nine children, five sons and four daughters.
