Obit: Sandra Kaiser

• Sandra Kaiser, age 50, of Hoven, died Monday, October 13, 2003 at Avera St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen. Her Mass of Christian Burial was held Thursday, October 16, 2003 at St. Anthony's Catholic Church, Hoven, with Father Lance Oser, celebrant. Burial followed at St. Anthony's Catholic Church Cemetery, Hoven. Lector was Chuck Simon and Eucharistic Minister was Don Seurer. Mass servers were Jason Hageman, Jeff Hageman, and Sam McCloud. Organist was Alice Simon, St. Anthony's Catholic Church Choir sang and soloist

• Sandra Kay Peterson, daughter of Christina (Landfried) and Frank Peterson, was born at Ipswich on October 8, 1953. She and her family lived on a farm 10 miles north and 5 miles west of Ipswich. She attended Adrian TWSHP rural School through 4th grade and Ipswich elementary through 6th grade. Her family then moved to a farm 11 miles south and 2 miles east of Bowdle. Sandy attended school in Bowdle, graduating with the BHS class of 1971. She then attended and graduated from Stewarts School of Hairstyling in Aberdeen. Following her schooling, she stayed in Aberdeen where she worked at Ben Franklin. She married Durran Kaiser at Hoven on January 26, 1974. They settled in Hoven where Sandy worked on their farm and raised her family. She went to work at Bob's Food Fair in Hoven (currently Krueger's Food Fair) in the early 1990's and was employed there the remainder of her life. She was a member of St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Hoven, St. Anthony's Altar Society, and belonged to the Holy Infant Hospital Auxiliary. Sandy enjoyed fishing, gardening, raising flowers, reading, and sewing.
