Well Known Farmer Passes to Great Beyond on Monday.

A life that was loved by many, and a life which had been devoted to usefulness, was blotted out on Monday morning, at 10:00 o'clock, when Herman Kepke, succumbed to a sudden attack of heart trouble.

Herman Kepke was born in Germany, August 8th, 1860. When he was seven years of age his parents moved to Watertown, Wisconsin, where he was reared to manhood. He was united in marriage to Augusta Lietz, February 14th, 1884, moving to Groton soon after their marriage, living on his farm north of this city until his death, Monday, April 11, 1921.

He leaves to mourn his loss four sisters, three brothers and one half-brother; six children, Lawrence, Arthur, John, Irving, Walter and Mrs. Ralph Mohr; his life companion and a host of friends.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon, (Thursday) at the farm home, Rev. C. B. Harrold officiating. The body will be laid to rest in the Groton Union cemetery.
