ARTHUR KUEHNERT.

Arthur Kuehnert died on Sunday evening, about six o'clock from complications following scarlet fever.

The home was quarantined some three weeks since on account of the fever, and ten days since the quarantine was raised.

The new ailment suddenly developed a dropsical condition, which showed serious symptoms on Friday last.

Mr. Kuehnert, who was in Wisconsin on his way home from Ohio, was telegraphed for, but the telegram did not reach him soon enough to enable him to reach home Sunday. A letter written Thursday was received by him on Friday, saying all were getting along well at home. The fatal telegram telling him of the child's death reached him in St. Paul Monday. The death of the little boy was a great bereavement to the entire family, and all sympathize with them.

Funeral services were held at the home at two o'clock Wednesday.
