Clement H. Kindschy, 87, died Monday, June 25, in Spokane, Wash., after having been in declining health the past four months. Funeral services were held Friday, June 29 at 11 a.m., in the Holland-Bonine Funeral Home, with burial in Highland Cemetery.

Born in Groton, he received his education here. He went to the Hingham, Mont., area and homesteaded in 1912. In 1924 he started work for the Northern Montana Experimental Station at Fort Assiniboine and worked there for 35 years. He had lived in Spokane for 15 years since his retirement.

Kindschy and Lilly Stelter were married in 1916 in Hingham. She died in 1964. He is survived by a son, John J.
