FOUND DEAD

John King, Aged 45, Found Dead In Bed

Last Sunday morning John King, who was employed by W. H. Preston was found dead by his bedfellow, one of the Preston boys, when the latter awoke.

King had been coming to this country for a number of years, and was all right but for a liking for strong drink.

He was a soldier in the Philippines, having seen service for a little more than a year in 1898-9 His home was formerly in Connecticut, but he enlisted in the service from Montana. The body was buried in Union Cemetery on Monday.
