## Harold Kludt

Services for Harold Kludt, 56, who died at his home at Claremont, Thursday were held at 2 p. m. Monday in the Claremont Methodist Church.

The Rev. Preston Brown officiated. Burial was in the Groton cemetery with military rites by the Claremont American Legion Post.
