

# Beverlee "Peg" Kranhold

Beverlee (Peg) Cranhold, 69, died in Las Vegas October 27, 1990. There will be a Mass Memorial Service at St. John, the Baptist Catholic Church, Groton, at 10 a.m. Friday, Nov. 9, 1990, with the Rev. John Garvey officiating.

Burial will be at Groton Union Cemetery.

She was born December 9, 1920 at Groton to Alphonse and Mary (Behres) Wattier. She grew up in Groton and graduated from Groton High School in 1938.
