Funeral services for Mrs. Paul (Emma) Kranzler, 66, of 906 4th Ave. N.E. Aberdeen, a former Andover resident, were held Thursday, July 3, at 4 p.m., at the Plymouth Congregational Church. The Rev. John H. Brooks and the Rev. Emanuel Backle officiated. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Mrs. Kranzler died July 1 at St. Luke's Hospital.

Emma Job, the daughter of John L. and Katherine Job, was born on December 7, 1908, in McPherson County near Hosmer. She attended school and grew up there. She was married to Paul Kranzler at Hillsview on June 12, 1932. They lived on a farm near Hosmer until 1944 when they moved to Aberdeen. In 1950 they moved to Andover and owned and operated the Gamble's Store there until 1957, when they moved back to Aberdeen, where they have been residents since.

She was a member of Plymouth Congregational Church at Aberdeen.

She is survived by her widower; one son, Lyle Kranzler, Watertown; and four brothers.
