## Herbert Kroll

Services for Herbert Kroll, 55, of 504 7th Ave., S.E., Aberdeen, former Andover area resident, were held Saturday, June 10, at 2 p.m. at the Zion Lutheran Church in Andover. The Rev. R.A. Giese of Aberdeen and the Rev. Edwin Rumerfield of Andover officiated and burial was in the Andover Cemetery.

A prayer service was held Friday evening at Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel.

Mr. Kroll died at his home on Wednesday, June 7.

Music was provided by the church choir who sang "The 23rd Psalm." The congregation sang "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" and "Beautiful Savior," accompanied by Mrs. Arthur Raap, organist.
