Services for William W. Kroll, 43, Andover, were held at 2 p. m., Wednesday, March 30 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Andover with the Rev. H. A. Kriefall officiating. Interment was in the Andover cemetery.

Mr. Kroll suffered a heart attack while returning home from an auto ride with his family, Sunday afternoon. He was dead on arrival at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.
