## Herman Krueger

Funeral services for Herman P. Krueger, 87, Conde, were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in St. Paul's Lutheran Church at Ferney with the Rev. Larry Geyer officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens.

He died Saturday, Sept. 6, 1986, at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen. He was a retired farmer.
