

# Hollace A. Krueger 8-17-88

The funeral for Hollace A. Krueger, 68, Groton, was held Monday, Aug. 15 in the United Methodist Church, Groton. The Rev. Wayne Tieszen officiated.

Burial followed in Sunset Memorial Gardens in Aberdeen under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel. Masonic rites were performed by Groton Masonic Lodge 65.
