Mrs. Paul E. Krueger was born Lora Millman in Elk Grove, Wis., June 20, 1884. She attended rural school and Plattville Normal and also a year at State College, Brookings, after her family moved to South Dakota around 1900. She worked in a law office in Clark and then in a bank there for several years. On Oct. 13, 1916 she was united in marriage to Paul E. Krueger, Groton, and to this union a daughter, Margaret was born.

The Kruegers lived on the farm just west of Groton until 1949 when they moved to Groton and have lived here since.

Mrs. Krueger was a member of the Presbyterian Church and the United Presbyterian Women, the Eastern Star, the DAR, the Merifu Club and the Henry Benefit and Social Club.

She passed away after several months illness at her home on May 1, 1964 at the age of 79 years. She leaves her husband, Paul; daughter Mrs. Robert (Margaret) Brigham of Havre, Mont.; four grandchildren and one brother, Benjamin Millman of Flandreau.

Funeral services were held at the Presbyterian Church Monday, May 4th, with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating.
